Solutions

3. What comedy pair is famous for the "Who's on first?" routine: George Burns and Gracie Allen or Abbott and Costello?

Answer: Abbott and Costello. A gold record of "Who's on first?" was placed in 1956 in the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum in Cooperstown, New York.

4. What state is known as the "Lone Star State": Ohio or Texas?

Answer: Texas. The lone star can be found on both the Texas flag and seal.



5. Which word is a noun: *gently* or *boat*?

Answer: *Boat*. A noun is a person, place, or thing. *Gently* is an adverb.

6. How many degrees are in a circle: 180 or 360?

Answer: 360. There are 180 degrees in a straight line.

7. Is *C.O.D.* the abbreviation for "cash on discount" or "cash on delivery"?

Answer: Cash on delivery. It can also stand for "collect on delivery."

8. Which word is the international radio telephone distress signal: *ten-four* or *mayday*?

Answer: *Mayday* is used by ships and aircraft when in distress.

9. What actress starred in *Spellbound*: Jane Fonda or Ingrid Bergman?

Answer: Ingrid Bergman. The actress was born in Sweden on August 29, 1915.

10. Zoology is the study of what: rocks or animals?

Answer: Animals. Geology is the study of rocks and minerals.

11. What is the wettest state in the United States: Arizona or Hawaii?

Answer: Hawaii. The average rainfall in Hawaii is 17.13 inches per year. The average in Arizona is 8.04 inches.

12. Which is the capital of Egypt: Rome or Cairo?

Answer: Cairo. It is the largest city in Egypt with a population of 9.5 million.
